1. No person, other than a licensed contractor or employees of a licensed contractor, shall engage in electrical, plumbing or mechanical business, construction, installation or maintenance unless duly licensed in accordance with this section. Expert from Sec. 7-130, Lees Summit Code of Ordinances.

Action required - Provide the name of the licensed plumbing contractor prior to permit approval.

2. 2005 NEC 517.13 - Grounding of receptacles and fixed electric equipment in patient care areas. Wiring in patient care areas shall comply with 517.13(A) and 517.13(B).

Action required - Indicate on the plans which rooms will be used for patient exam rooms and provide information on how this requirement will be met.

1. 2006 IFC 901.2- Construction documents. The fire code official shall have the authority to require construction documents and calculations for all fire protection systems and to require permits be issued for the installation, rehabilitation or modification of any fire protection system. Construction documents for fire protection systems shall be submitted for review and approval prior to system installation.

Provide sprinkler alteration plans for review and approval.

2. 2006 IFC 901.6- Inspection, testing and maintenance. Fire detection, alarm and extinguishing systems shall be maintained in an operative condition at all times, and shall be replaced or repaired where defective. Not required fire protection systems and equipment shall be inspected, tested and maintained or removed.

The existing sprinkler system shall have documentation of a current annual inspection. Verified at inspection.

- 3. The correct occupancy group for this tenant is a B. Correct the drawings and the occupant load
- 4. Existing exit signage and emerrgency lighting subject to site inspection.
- 5. 2006 IFC 906.2 General requirements. Portable fire extinguishers shall be selected, installed and maintained in accordance with this section and NFPA 10.

Provide a minimum of one, 2A:10B:C fire extinguisher at a conspicuous location.
