

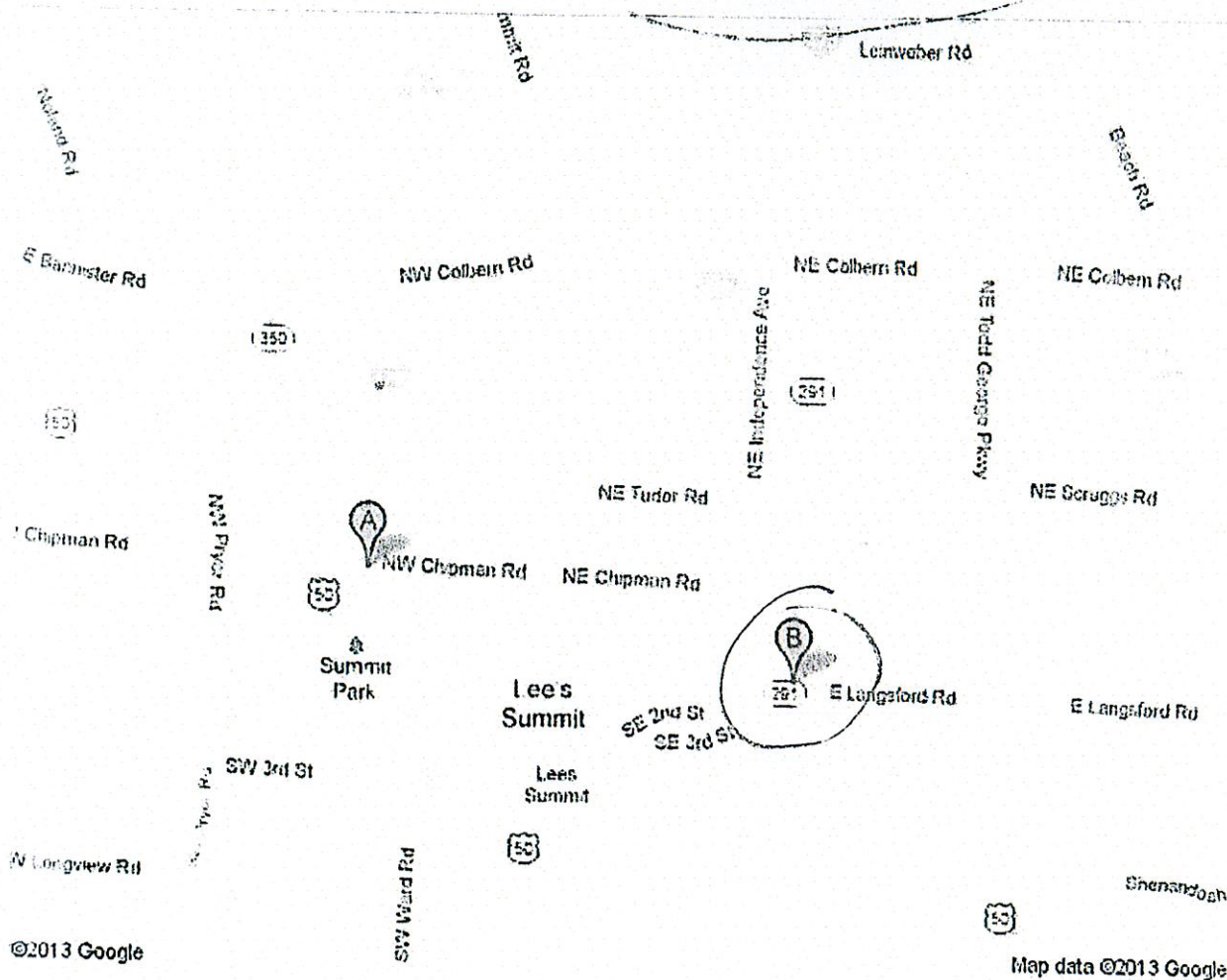

5. Organizations will be charged a minimum fee of \$25 for departmental removal of any signs due to failure of the organization to follow the above instructions.

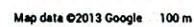

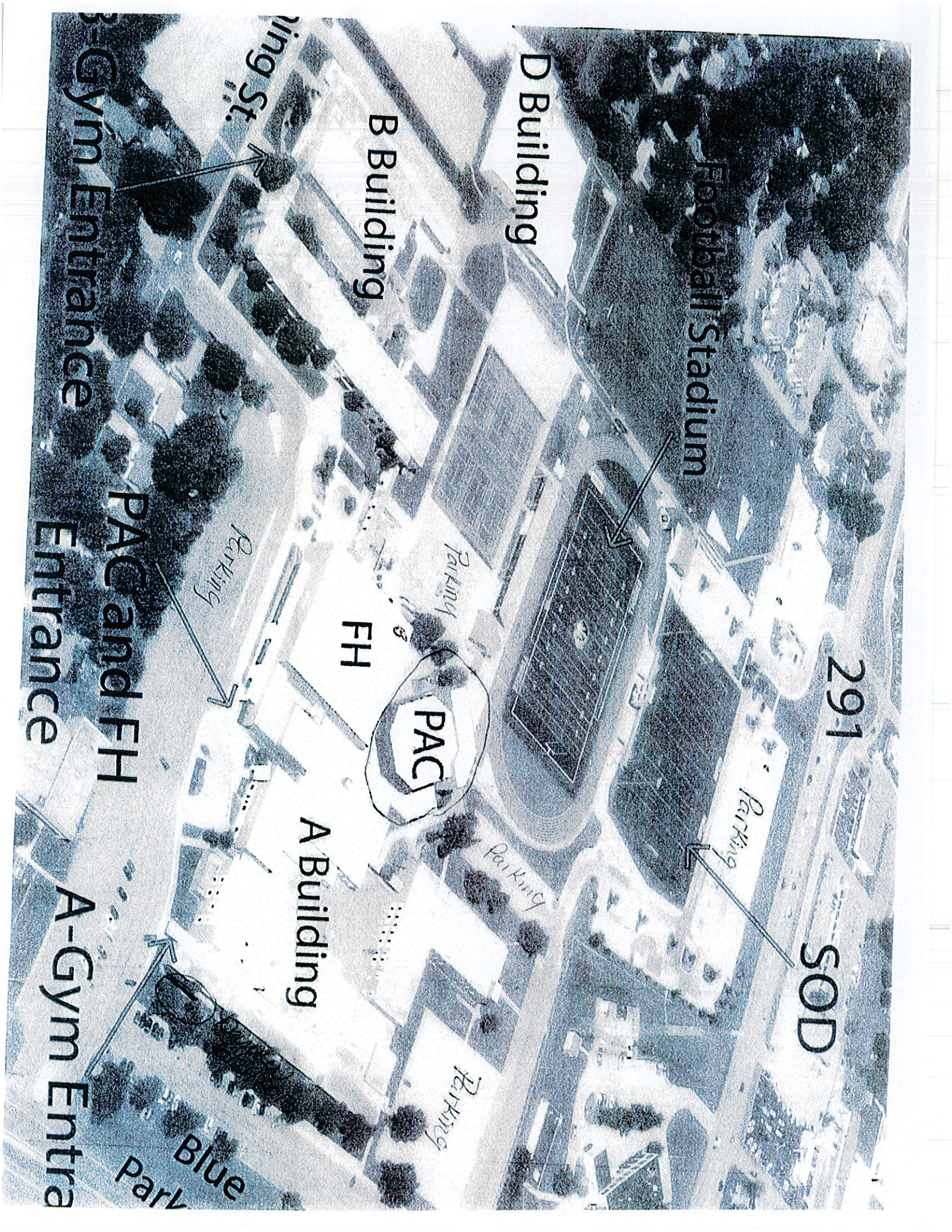

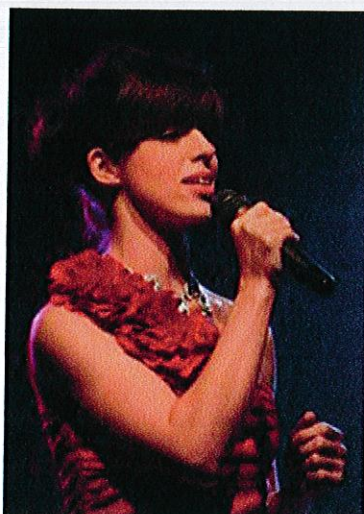
