1. 20 IFC 901.2- Construction documents. The fire code official shall have the authority to require construction documents and calculations for all fire protection systems and to require permits be issued for the installation, rehabilitation or modification of any fire protection system. Construction documents for fire protection systems shall be submitted for review and approval prior to system installation. PROVIDE AS BUILT PLANS FOR ANY ALTERATIONS TO THE SPRINKLER SYSTEM.

2. 2012 IFC 901.5- Installation acceptance testing. Fire detection and alarm systems, fire-extinguishing systems, fire hydrant systems, fire standpipe systems, fire pump systems, private fire service mains and all other fire protection systems and appurtenances thereto shall be subject to acceptance tests as contained in the installation standards and as approved by the fire code official. The fire code official shall be notified before any required acceptance testing. The fire code official shall be notified 48 hours before any required acceptance test.

TESTING OF ANY RELOACTED ALARM DEVICES IS REQUIRED. TO SCHEDULE A TEST CONTACT THE FIRE DEAPRTMENT AT 816-969-1300

The approval of plans and specifications does not permit the violation of any section of the Building Codes or other City Ordinances or State Law.
