The water samples passe last December for this water line but the new main on village park dr. was never connected to view high dr. and the construction taps were never removed. On friday 9/27 the main was chlorinated again so we will dechlorinate and take samples on line 2 of the water main going down village park dr.

Resolved

The water line has been re-tested and has received passing tests from Keystone Lab. The water line at View High and Village Park has been tied in and is in full service. The fire hydrants have all been turned toward the street and raised if they needed it. This now completes all the water for this permit.

As per the agreement they are only installing sidewalks on the east side of Kessler dry. The sidewalks have all been formed and rock was installed and compacted. I spoke with Ryan and we are letting them keep about 25-30 ft. open on the ease side of Kessler so they can get their heavy equipment across the road without breaking the sidewalk. The sidewalk has all been poured down Kessler and down the portion of village park dr. to the dead end. They also poured ADA ramps at the corner of Kessler and village park dr. 2 of the ramps have failed and are not in compliance. Everything else seems to be in compliance.
