

We held a drop-off event in downtown Lee's Summit last year and used the parking lot across from the train depot where the new Reece Nichols office is currently being built.

We are interested in doing an event like that again this year, on Saturday Dec 14th from 4-7. Last year we used that parking lot an over-flowed onto the side walk a bit. It was an amazing event and we collected tons of toys. We had Craig Rookstool and the Moose Mobile/Crown Town Cruiser there and had it decorated for Christmas.

This year, since there is a building going in on that site, we were interested in using some of the parking spots that are right in front of that new building site. We are requesting about 60' of space. I have attached the aerial of the site. Since there isn't a current business there we would not be blocking their frontage in any way.

We honestly don't know what to expect as far a flow of people. We have lined up to have Brecken on the morning show of Mix 93.3 and 810 sports. He will also be on the morning show of Fox4. We will also be working to get him on Channel 9. We hope to make this event very successful, but ultimately we have no way to predict turnout to this event.

Brecken has a heart for helping people and he loves events like this. You may have seen him on the news regularly for his fundraising for first responders. He has raised about \$11k over the past 2 years for our local first responders through his lemonade stands. If you do a quick google search of Brecken Simmons you will see some of his background and the projects he works on.
