• The demolition of structures or buildings, partial or complete, shall require a demolition permit. The removal of onestory detached accessory structures used as tool and storage sheds, playhouses, and similar uses, provided the floor area PERMIT REQUIREMENTS does not exceed one hundred twenty (120) square feet does not require a demolition permit. • When requested by the Building Official, the applicant shall provide; a structural engineers report that describes the methods of demolition including all necessary shoring; plans and information necessary to determine no hazards will be created that endanger the occupants, adjoing properties or general public. • Gas and electric services must be properly abandoned and approved by the appropriate utility company prior to issuance of a permit for complete removal of a structure. Appropriate documentation from the electrical and gas companies documenting proper abandonment. · Water and sanitary services must be abandoned by the Water Utilities Departmentprior to issuance of a permit for comlete removal of a structure. Contact Water Utilites at 816-969-1900 for additional information. • A right-of-way permit and possibly a traffic control permit are required for work located in the row-of-way. Contact the Public Works Department at 816-969-1800 for more information and permit requirements and issuance. • Applicant shall furnish a certificate of liability insurance for personal and property damage in a minimum amount of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) injury each person, three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) each occurance, and fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) property damage. Private disposal systems - The removal of private sanitary waste systems is regulated by the Department of Public Works. Jackson County Planning and Environmental Health.
