PERMIT REQUIREMENTS

NSPECTIONS

- The demolition of structures or buildings, partial or complete, shall require a demolition permit. The removal of onestory detached accessory structures used as tool and storage sheds, playhouses, and similar uses, provided the floor area does not exceed one hundred twenty (120) square feet does not require a demolition permit.
- When requested by the Building Official, the applicant shall provide; a structural engineers report that describes the methods of demolition including all necessary shoring; plans and information necessary to determine no hazards will be created that endanger the occupants, adjoing properties or general public.
- Water, sanitary, gas and electric services must be properly abandoned and approved by the appropriate utility company prior to issuance of a permit for complete removal of a structure. A right-of-way permit must be obtained from the City of Lee's Summit for the abandonment of the water and sanitary services. The work must be completed and the permit closed prior to issuance of the demolition permit. Appropriate documentation from the electrical and gas companies documenting proper abandonment.
- Applicant shall furnish a certificate of liability insurance for personal and property damage in a minimum amount of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) injury each person, three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) each occurance, and fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) property damage.
- Private disposal systems The removal of private sanitary waste systems is regulated by the Department of Public Works, Jackson County Planning and Environmental Health. Please contact them at 816-881-4515 for further information.
- Contact the City of Lee's Summit Fire Department, 816-969-1300, PRIOR to removal of any underground fuel storage
- Demolition waste and the abatement of hazardous materials is regulated by the Missouri Department of Natural Resources. For information regarding demolition waste regulations contact the Hazardous Waste Program at 573-751-3176. For information regarding asbestos contact Air Pollution Control at 573-751-4817. - Burning of demolition waste of any kind is not allowed in the City of Lee's Summit.
- The applicant shall remove all rubbish and materials and fill excavations to existing grade so that the premises are left in a safe and sanitary condition and can be maintained in accordance with the Property Maintenance Code within twenty-eight (28) days from the date of demolition.
- A final inspection shall be scheduled after all work required by the demolition permit has been competed
- Permits issued for demolition work shall be valid for a maximum duration of sixty (60) days.
