The sale, offering for sale, possession, storage, handling and use of certain Division 1.4G fireworks shall be permitted within the corporate limits of the City, provided such fireworks comply with Chapter 320 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri, 11 CSR 40-3.010, CPSC 16 CFR, Parts 1500-1507, DOT 49 CFR, Parts 100-178, and all applicable Ordinances and Codes of the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri, except that it shall be unlawful for any person to sell, offer to sell, possess, store, handle or use, within the corporate limits of the City, the following Division 1.4G fireworks:

- Rockets on a stick (e.g. bottle rockets);
- Missiles with fins or rudders for the purpose of achieving aerodynamic flight;
- Roman Candles, California Candles, Illuminating Torches, or similar items, with or without spikes, which contain wording on the caution label that is substantially similar to the following: "WARNING SHOOTS FLAMING BALLS" or "WARNING SHOOTS FLAMING BALLS AND REPORTS"; and
- Single or multi-shot parachutes, with night effects.

(Chapter 13 – Fire Prevention and Protection, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Lee's Summit, Article III Fire Code, Section 13-44 Same Amendments.)

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Written Narrative Description of the Proposed Event

Description of Event: Fireworks Stand for Robert L Clore 189 American Legion

Timeline of event:

- On June 23rd, or thereafter, we will erect a tent for the intended use of selling fireworks.
- On or about June 24th our group will begin to set up the interior of the tent with the various items necessary to sell, including: tables, lights, cords, signs, etc. Following this initial setup, we will schedule inspection with the Lee's Summit Fire Department.
- On or about June 24th, and following the Fire District's approval, the fireworks will be delivered to the site, unboxed, priced, and placed on the tables for sale.
- Following all required approvals by city, sales will commence to the public.
- On the evening of July 4th we will close the sale of fireworks to the public and return any unsold items to fireworks vendor.
- On July 5th & 6th tent, tables, electrical lights & cords, trash and debris will be removed from grounds.

Hours of Operation: Our intent is to remain manned and open from the hours of 8:00 am through 11:00 pm each day of sales.

<u>Anticipated Attendance</u>: We expect to serve from several hundred to upwards of over a thousand people during the 5 days of sales.

Signs and Attention-Getting Devices:

• Two 2' x 8' plastic banners attached to the tent stating the words: "Fireworks".

<u>**Public Toilets</u>**: No public toilets will be necessary nor be provided to the public. Stand workers will use a porta-potty facility.</u>

Electrical Plan: We intend to pull electricity from a nearby GFI outlet or portable generator. All cords and light stringers will be UL Rated, with safety guards.

Signage Plan

The following is a description of the signage plan pursuant to the Lee's Summit Fireworks Code.

Our signage will consist of two 3' x 10' plastic banners securely attached to the sidewalls of the fireworks tent facing the adjacent roadway.

We also will use a 32 sq. foot banner and a 12" x 12" sign around the checkout area, displaying our non-for profit group name, as per city ordinance.

Our group plans to use none of the following signs or attention-getting devices:

- •Moving/Flashing Arrow

Security Plan

The following is a description of the security plan pursuant to the Lee's Summit Fireworks Code.

Our group will hire a security guard from 11:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m., or whenever our stand is not open to the public for business as per city regulations, from the evening of June 24th through the morning of July 4th.

The security guard will be licensed and approved with the Lee's Summit Police Department, pursuant to Lee's Summit Fireworks Code 3301.2.2 E "Security Plan". The exact name of the guard(s) is unknown at this time as we are currently in negotiation with several security companies, each of which currently provides security guards, licensed and approved through the Lee's Summit Police Department.
