DIVIDING A JOB INTO TWO OR MORE PARTIAL PERMITS WILL RESULT IN HIGHER TOTAL PERMIT FEES THAN ONE FULL PERMIT. RESUBMITTAL PLANS REVIEW FEES MAY BE DUE WHEN PREVIOUSLY IDENTIFIED DEFICIENCIES REMAIN UNCORRECTED ON SUBSEQUENT SUBMITTALS.
