You are correct. I was thinking this was a toilet constructed under the 1999 ADA which would have excepted compliance with the 2010 for the sink clearance, but since we are putting in a new sink, I correct the wall and clearance and show this detail on revised sheet A1.4.

 2.5 BSE Structural Engineers have been looking at this condition and prepared the attached report. The Mechanical Engineer provided this information: Unit weight Unit weight existing new
RTU -12 1950 lbs. 2200 lbs. RTU - 13 0 900 lbs.

BSE has reviewed the loads with the existing joist and found the joists do not require any modification. I have attached BSE's report.



- 2.6 GFCI HBE Response: The drawings have been modified to show that all receptacles within 6' of a sink will be GFCI protected.
