

## RE: Pyro-Guard Fire Rated Wall for Villas at Woodside Lots 1-14

On June 14, 2021, Summit Homes contacted Everstead to evaluate the Pyro-Guard sheathing that was installed at the above referenced property. The purpose was to verify that the Pyro-Guard wall sheathing covered with vapor barrier and stucco would be sufficient to meet the product guidelines. The findings are below.

## Findings:

- The Pyro-Guard is only acceptable for interior walls per the Fire-Retardant-Treated Wood Selector Chart as shown in the link below.

- Per the UL Evaluation Report UL ER7002-01, the use of Pyro-Guard wood products used in exterior
  wall assemblies requires a resistive barrier on the outside of the wall during construction as shown
  in note 24 on page 10 of 12 in the link below.

- Since the Pyro-Guard is covered with a vapor barrier and stucco, the requirements of ER7002-01 are met and is an applicable use of the Pyro-Guard.
- Exterior wall is rated for a one-hour per IBC 2018 Table 720.1(2) item 15-1.3 and is detailed below.
