Re: Chase Bank/890 NE Langsford Road - Code of Ordinances Section 8.330. CPTED Report

Dear Mr. Frogge:

Please accept this letter report as satisfying the Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design criteria for this Chase bank location, per Section 9.120. Bank/Financial Services (Amend. #33) per each subdivision — although D.3 and E are not provided, according to Chase security standards and notes below. Chase agrees to add the required height strip and "no loitering/trespass" sign at the entrance, which are additional items, beyond the Chase security standard.

A. Lighting requirements

- 1. Indoor-lobby in coordination with the Chase security team, Chase standard interior lighting intensity will support high resolution digital video data from the Chase security camera system.
- 2. Outdoor Minimum lighting levels at the entrance will exceed 5 footcandles by several multiples, per photometric calculations, prior experience and measurement.

B. Employee protection

- 1. There is no walk-in vault at this branch, and therefore no hard-wired vault phone installation.
- 2. Disguises, caps, sunglasses, and visors, etc., are not permitted.
- C. Video surveillance camera(s), two-color digital high-definition requirements 1 through 4 are all standard video requirements for the Chase security system provided.

D. Alarm system

- 1. Alarm system is monitored off-site.
- 2. Silent panic alarm is provided at each cash register.
- 3. Remote wearable alarms are not provided for each teller/employee directly accessible to the public, per Chase security standards.
- 4. Alarm activation within a walk-in vault is standard for Chase security measures, yet not applicable at this branch there is no walk-in vault.











- E. Automatic door lock required No automatic door locks are available to function from cash transaction counters, which are compatible with Chase standard security hardware, and cannot be provided.
- F. Visibility maintained
 - 1. Unobstructed lines of sight are maintained from the cash register to the front door.
 - 2. Windows will be kept free from visibility blockers.
- G. Height strips will be added for the public entrance in direct view of employees, at the interior vestibule door jamb.
- H. "No Loitering/trespass" sign will be posted within the 24-hour vestibule, beside the ATM.
