#### LSPR Night Flight 5k planning and execution

**Description:** This is the 40th Annual Night Flight 5K Run. The route will begin and end at the Legacy Park Amphitheater. The course features a scenic route on the Legacy trail. Participants will be allowed to enjoy yard games and make smores in the Legacy Park Amphitheater venue after the race. The event is co-sponsored by Lee's Summit Medical Center and Lee's Summit Parks and Recreation (contact: Jodi Jordan, Assistant Superintendent of Recreation Services)

**Date:** Night Flight is an annual 5k race typically held on the first Friday in June. Due to Covid restrictions the 2021 race was pushed back to the fall. This year's event will be held on Friday, October 1, 2021. This is the 40<sup>th</sup> year anniversary for this event.

**Narrative:** The event starts and finishes at the Legacy Park Amphitheater. The run will use the trails and roadways (Bluestem drive and Legacy Park Drive) of Legacy Park. The amphitheater parking lot, restrooms and venue will be used for pre and post event activities.

**Time:** The run is scheduled to start at 9:00pm. The event will conclude by 11:00pm. Attendance: Estimating 300-350 runners at the event

#### LSPD:

Police will not be needed for this event as runners will be on the trail or Legacy Park Drive which will be closed off with barricades and monitored by volunteers.

#### LSFD:

LSFD to provide EMT unit on site of event. If not available will stay in communication with the event coordinator of any issues/assist calls they receive from runners

#### Site plan:

Exact route not yet finalized. 5K will start at Legacy Park Amphitheater and use the trail, and parts of Legacy Park Drive. Staff and volunteers will close down the park entrances and the entrance to Bluestem and Legacy Park drive while runners are still on the course.
