Clean Indoor Air Ordinance:
The City of Lees Summit has an ordinance which prohibits smoking in virtually all enclosed areas of public places and places of employment. Per the ordinance, a "No Smoking" sign or the international "No Smoking" symbol (consisting of a burning cigarette enclosed in a red circle with a red bar across it) shall be clearly and conspicuously posted at every entrance where smoking is prohibited. The person who owns, manages, operates or otherwise controls a public place or place of employment is responsible for compliance with the Clean Indoor Air Act.
