

Safety and liability

- *When delivery on private property is specified, damage of any kind to sidewalks, curbs, driveways, buildings, trees, shrubs, lawn, etc. is at customer’s risk.
- *Note: This concrete is accurately weighed by computer while the batch weights for each load are recorded. The water/ cement ratio is designed for optimum strength and durability. We cannot assume responsibility for the concrete if excessive water is added to the mix.
- *Customers holding trucks beyond 5 minutes per cubic yard will be charged for “truck time”.
- *For Deliveries Made in Missouri: Notice to Owner

Failure to secure lien waivers may result in your paying for labor and material twice.

Seek immediate medical attention if you have persistent or severe discomfort. In case of eye contact, flush with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Consult a physician immediately.
