1. 2018 IFC 901.2- Construction documents. The fire code official shall have the authority to require construction documents and calculations for all fire protection systems and to require permits be issued for the installation, rehabilitation or modification of any fire protection system. Construction documents for fire protection systems shall be submitted for review and approval prior to system installation.

2. 2018 IFC 901.5- Installation acceptance testing. Fire detection and alarm systems, fire-extinguishing systems, fire hydrant systems, fire standpipe systems, fire pump systems, private fire service mains and all other fire protection systems and appurtenances thereto shall be subject to acceptance tests as contained in the installation standards and as approved by the fire code official. The fire code official shall be notified before any required acceptance testing. The fire code official shall be notified 48 hours before any required acceptance test.

3. The civil plans call for the backflow to be in a vault in the yard to serve the sprinkler and private hydrant.

4. The plans call for the main to be piped to the exterior.

Action required- How do you plan to do this? Will it be piped to a suitable drain capable of handling a full flow

5. If the backflow is moved to the vault, a one way check valve is required at the base of the riser.
