4. Description of the site on which the proposed event is to be held.


Race for the Future 5K Run/Walk is proposed to begin at Lee's Summit West High School near the Activity Complex behind the high school. Participants will run up the drive toward Ward Road, turn left (north) on Ward (remaining next to the curb in south-bound lane to minimize traffic disruption) to a turnaround point South of Scherer Road, turn left and circle back on adjacent walking trail/sidewalk, then turn right into Lee's Summit West parking lot. Participants will continue along the tennis fields and back near the baseball fields and return to the football field. The race begins and ends on the track.

5. Date(s) of proposed event: Saturday, October 12, 2024

12. City Services/Public Streets: Our annual race route involves closure of a portion of one lane (South-bound) of Ward Rd. between Lee's Summit West High School's north entrance and Scherer Road. We'd request traffic control assistance from the LSPD to assist in oversight/enforcement of this road closure for safety.
