



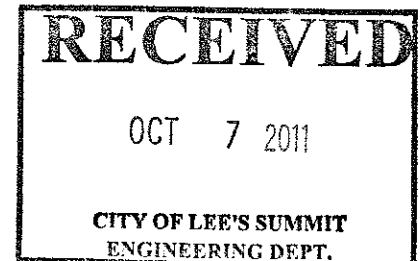

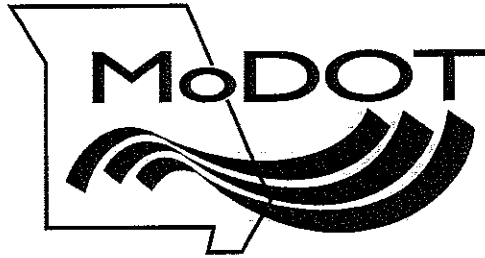

A final inspection of the above referenced project was conducted on the 5th of May, 2011 by Mr. Michael Thomas of the Missouri Department of Transportation; Mr. Rodney Hudson, Jerry Johnson and David Wahl of the City of Lee's Summit; Mr. Brad Boyles of Mega Industries, Inc.; Mr. Tom Rottinghaus.

The inspection of the project Noted minor deficiencies which have all been corrected.

A total of 120 calendar days were allocated in the contract, time was suspended 12/23/10 (23) days for revised power supply unit to meet the utility requirements. Time was suspended again from 1/27/11 to 3/18/11 (50) days to be in seeding specifications. The seeding was completed on 3/21/11. Due to conflicts of schedule between the City Staff and MoDOT the final inspection and acceptance of field work was not completed on May 5, 2011. A total of 96 calendar days were used to complete the project. The DBE goal for this project was 15 per cent.
