Re: Steel columns - general letter regarding sizing and materials

Vista Structural Engineering, LLC, was asked to address the following general question about columns used for residential construction projects:


- Can schedule 40 columns be used in place of 11 gauge columns? 3" Schedule 40 columns are stronger than 3" and 3 ½" 11 gauge columns and can replace them per the marked up steel column and pad footing schedule on the following page of this letter. The two 11 gauge columns for options 'A' and 'B' can be replaced with 3" schedule 40 steel columns. Schedule 40 columns shall have the ASTM Designation of A53 Grade B or A500 Grade B. The measurement of a 3" schedule 40 column shall be as follows:
 - 3" nominal size
 - 3.5" external diameter
 - 0.216" wall thickness
- This applies for columns up to 10'-0" in height.


