This project proposes a white box renovation and repair of the south portion of the existing building; the addition of new bunk rooms, restrooms, and support spaces for EMS drivers in the north portion of the building; removal of the existing roof/soffit at select locations on the north and south facades to accommodate a new flat roof and facade; complete demolition of the existing porte cochere; and the addition of a new ambulance bay structure.

#### Clean Indoor Air Ordinance:

The City of Lee's Summit has an ordinance which prohibits smoking in virtually all enclosed areas of public places and places of employment. Per the ordinance, a "No Smoking" sign or the international "No Smoking" symbol (consisting of a burning cigarette enclosed in a red circle with a red bar across it) shall be clearly and conspicuously posted at every entrance where smoking is prohibited. The person who owns, manages, operates or otherwise controls a public place or place of employment is responsible for compliance with the Clean Indoor Air Act. Prior to issuance of the Certificate of Occupancy, 20% of the total tax will be due and payable in addition to proper security for the balance of the tax (tax surety bond, letter of credit or cash bond). On each anniversary date of the Certificate of Occupancy, for four years thereafter, 20% of the tax will be due, plus interest charged by the City on the balance of the tax. #### E. PAYMENT OF THE LICENSE TAX

**RESIDENTIAL:** PAYMENT OF THE LICENSE TAX IS DUE **PRIOR** TO THE ISSUANCE OF THE BUILDING PERMIT AND IS TO BE **PAID IN THE TREASURY DIVISION OF THE FINANCE DEPARTMENT.** A COPY OF THE LICENSE TAX BILL CAN BE OBTAINED FROM THE DEVELOPMENT SERVICES DEPARTMENT WITHIN THE TIME PERIOD POSTED. - This exemption is not assignable or transferable. It is an exemption from sales and use taxes
  only and is not an exemption from real or personal property tax.

- Individuals making personal purchases may not use this exemption.
- A contractor may purchase and pay for construction materials exempt from sales tax when fulfilling a contract with your organization only if your organization issues a project exemption certificate and the contractor makes purchases in compliance with the provisions of Section 144.062, RSMo.
- Sales by your organization are not subject to sales or use tax if conducted within your organization's exempt charitable religious and educational functions and activities.
- Sales not directly related to your exemplatination that are made only to raise funds for your organization, are not exempt unless such sales are occasional or isolated.
- If your organization engages in a competitive commercial business that serves the general public, even if the profits are used for your exempt charitable, religious and educational functions, you must obtain a Missouri Retail Sales Tax License and collect and remit state and local sales tax.
- Any alteration to this exemption letter renders it invalid.
