1. No person, other than a licensed contractor or employees of a licensed contractor, shall engage in electrical, plumbing or mechanical business, construction, installation or maintenance unless duly licensed in accordance with this section. Expert from Sec. 7-130, Lees Summit Code of Ordinances.

Action required - Provide the names of these contractors prior to permit approval.

2. The floor/ceiling assembly above rooms 1.111 and 1.112 is a fire-resistant assembly. Any penetrations of this assembly shall be sealed in an approved manner.

Action required - This will be verified on inspection.

1. 2006 IFC 901.2- Construction documents. The fire code official shall have the authority to require construction documents and calculations for all fire protection systems and to require permits be issued for the installation, rehabilitation or modification of any fire protection system. Construction documents for fire protection systems shall be submitted for review and approval prior to system installation.

Provide shop drawings for the clean agent systems for review and approval.

- 2. Acknowledging the marked out words on the submitted drawings. It is understood that NO automatic sprinkler systems or components will be removed and all areas will be protected in accordance with NFPA 13 and the IFC.
- 3. 2006 IFC 901.5- Installation acceptance testing. Fire detection and alarm systems, fire-extinguishing systems, fire hydrant systems, fire standpipe systems, fire pump systems, private fire service mains and all other fire protection systems and appurtenances thereto shall be subject to acceptance tests as contained in the installation standards and as approved by the fire code official. The fire code official shall be notified before any required acceptance testing. The fire code official shall be notified 48 hours before any required acceptance test.

Call (816) 969-1300 to schedule room fan tests and discharge tests.

4. 2006 IFC 901.6- Inspection, testing and maintenance. Fire detection, alarm and extinguishing systems shall be maintained in an operative condition at all times, and shall be replaced or repaired where defective. Not required fire protection systems and equipment shall be inspected, tested and maintained or removed.

The existing system shall have documentation of a current annual inspection. Verified at inspection.
