1. The water line plans shown on Sheet C500 are not quite correct. The restrained valve will need to be shown within the right of way (ideally within 1 foot of the right of way line). The water meter will need to also be placed within the right of way (ideally within 1 foot of the right of way line). Please see the Design and Construction Manual for specific guidance concerning placement of the restrained valve and the water meter in relation to the right of way line.

2. A blow-off assembly exists at the end of the 8" water line. This blow-off assembly should be noted as "to be removed", and appropriate labeling should be included which states how this will be capped. It may be more appropriate to install a bend at this location rather than capping the pipe.

3. Thrust blocks should be called out on the water line where appropriate. This includes the private portion of the water line (i.e., the fire line) where bends are introduced into the pipe.

4. Sheet C900 is referenced in the response to comments dated July 9, 2012 from John E. Wishniewski, AIA. It appears that this sheet is missing from the re-submittal.
