1. The Final Development Plan (FDP) application fee of \$600.00 shall be submitted to the Planning and Development Department before the FDP plans are signed by staff and the full building permit is released.

2. All roof mounted mechanical equipment shall be screened to the height of the units by the screening walls.

3. The base of the pole light fixtures shall not exceed three (3) feet above grade.

4. For reference only. Sign permits shall be submitted under separate applications(s).

5. For reference only. The dashed in future parking spaces shown on the very east drive will require a new Final Development Plan application at the time of their construction and will likely require additional parking lot screening shrubs.

1. The Engineer's Estimate of Probable Construction Costs has been accepted for this project, and the Public Works Review and Inspection Fee of \$10,260.55 (which is based on 3% of the total infrastructure cost plus a water test inspection fee) must be paid prior to the issuance of an infrastructure permit and/or the final processing of a building permit from the Codes Department.

2. Contact Public Works Inspections at (816) 969-1800 at least 48 hours prior to the onset of construction.

3. Contact a Right-of-Way Inspector at (816) 969-1800 prior to any land disturbance within the right-of-way. These activities may require a permit.

4. Please be aware that any future repair work to public infrastructure (e.g., water main repair, sanitary sewer repair, storm sewer repair, etc.) within public easements will not necessarily include the repair of pavement, curbing, landscaping, or other private improvements which are located within the easement.

5. Any public improvements will require two (2) CD ROMs with the plans in TIFF format.

6. Submit a Land Disturbance Permit application and the required attachments to the Erosion Control Specialist prior to any land disturbance activities that are to occur prior to obtaining a building permit from the Codes Department. Approval of these plans does not constitute approval of the erosion control plan. Contact Barton Reese at (816) 969-1800 for new land disturbance permitting details.

7. One (1) additional plan set is required for final processing. A set was missing from the submittal.

1. Fire Department-All building and life safety issues shall comply with the 2006 International Fire Code and local amendments as adopted by the City of Lee's Summit.

2. Fire Department- IFC 503.2.3 Fire apparatus access roads shall be designed and maintained to support the imposed loads of fire apparatus and shall be surfaced so as to provide all-weather driving capabilities.

3. Fire Department- IFC 506.1 Where access to or within a structure or an area is restricted because of secured openings or where immediate access is necessary for life-saving or fire-fighting purposes, the fire code official is authorized to require a key box to be installed in an approved location. The key box shall be of an approved type and shall contain keys to gain necessary access as required by the fire code official. An approved lock shall be installed on gates or similar barriers when required by the fire code official.

A Knox entry system shall be installed on both gates.
