- 3. Provide proof of general liability insurance for claims from injury or death and property damage in an amount approved by the City, but not less than \$2,000,000 per occurrence for personal injury and \$2,000,000 per occurrence for property damage with the City listed as an additional insured.

4. The property owner affidavit (part of the Final Development Plan application) is missing. This form is required as is the property owner signature on the FDP application. The submitted lease does not fullfill this requirement.
