- 1. An FAA form 7460 should be provided prior to construction.
- 2. An itemized and sealed Engineer's Estimate of Probable Construction Costs should accompany your final submittal drawings. The Engineering Plan Review and Inspection Fee is based on this estimate, and calculated at 3% of the total. Items to include in the estimate are: 1) grading, 2) concrete apron, 3) final restoration, including sodding, seeding, fertilizer, mulch, and topsoil.

1. All issues pertaining to life safety and property protection from the hazards of fire, explosion or dangerous conditions in new and existing buildings, structures and premises, and to the safety to fire fighters and emergency responders during emergency operations, shall be in accordance with the 2012 International Fire Code.

1. LIGHTING. Provide manufacturer specifications for the proposed exterior wall packs for review and approval. Fixtures shall have full 90-degree cut-offs so as to direct the light downward.
