- Studies Studies, such as stormwater and traffic, shall be provided in Portable Document Format (PDF).
- It is requested that each plan sheet be a maximum of 2MB.

1. The submitted landscaping plans are still incomplete and do not show the site as a whole. As such I am unable to provide comments on the proposed landscaping.

Please provide landscaping plans in accordance with the UDO that show the whole site including the proposed landscaping improvements along Hamblen Rd.

- 1. Sheet C.300: The outlet structure top elevation is shown in the inset as 1012.5. The profile view, however, shows the outlet structure top as 1011.0.
- 2. The grading plan will need to be revised on the above comment. There is insufficient freeboard between the 100 year water surface elevation of 1011.78 and the top of the detention basin berm.
- 3. The 15" HDPE called-out on Sheet C.300 for the incoming and outgoing pipe for the detention basin outlet structure does not appear to match the stormwater report dated Jan. 2, 2018. It appears the report describes a 24" pipe.
- 4. The flowline elevations for the 6" orifice on Sheet C.300 does not appear to match the elevation given in the stormwater report dated Jan. 2, 2018.
- 5. The flowline elevation for the 15" HDPE on Sheet C.300 does not appear to match the elevation shown in the stormwater report dated Jan. 2, 2018.
- 6. Sheet C.500: Why is DIP called-out instead of C900?
- 7. Cover Sheet: Please remove the sanitary sewer plans from the "Index of Sheets". The sanitary sewer plans are separate from the Final Development Plan.
