## **Traffic Review**

1. As shown, there is not enough plan detail for the sidewalk to layout or inspect its construction without using a scale on paper or electronic files. For example, the sidewalk has multiple curves in its alignment, but no reference to the radius of any curve. Nor is there any reference on the plan or typical section to a common offset or dimensioned distance behind the curb.

## **Electronic Plans for Resubmittal**
