1. SIGNAGE. Staff has received the application to the Planning Commission seeking approval of the proposed canopy signage and will begin processing the request. Staff will seek to place the application on the Planning Commission meeting agenda of August 26th or September 9th.

- 1. Include "Final Development Plans" within the headline of the cover sheet, instead of "100% construction documents"
- 2. Lee's Summit Public Works should be the designated agency for the storm utility lines on-site. Lee's Summit Water Utilities takes care of both the sanitary and water lines on-site.
- 3. Several sheets listed in the sheet list table are missing. Include, clarify or revise the table of contents shown on the cover sheet.
- 4. The minimum asphalt subgrade requirements that the City allows are made up of a 6" granular base course with geogrid or a 6" granular base course with a 6" chemically STABILIZED subgrade. Make sure to also indicate what type of stabilization chemical will be used during the process.
- 5. Throughout the set of plans, revise 5" concrete sidewalk to 5' concrete sidewalk. Make sure to also revise 6" asphalt paving to 6.5" asphalt paving.
- 6. Revise the hatching for new sidewalk shown on the ESC plan and landscape plan sheets to match the one shown on the paving plan sheet, in order to prevent any potential discrepancies.
- 7. Remove the site addition items from the EOOPCC estimate.

- 1. All issues pertaining to life safety and property protection from the hazards of fire, explosion or dangerous conditions in new and existing buildings, structures and premises, and to the safety to fire fighters and emergency responders during emergency operations, shall be in accordance with the 2018 International Fire Code.
- 2. Maintain existing egress from the structure during construction.
- 3. Automatic fire protection may need to be extended to the canopy depending on construction materials. Determined at building permit review.
