Excise Tax

On April 1, 1998, an excise tax on new development for road construction went into effect. This tax is levied based on the type of development and trips generated. Voluntary Residential Development Surcharge

In a combined effort with both the R-4 and the R-7 School Districts the City of Lee's Summit is working together to educate the development community on a new program, the "Lee's Summit Voluntary Residential Development Surcharge." Planning Review Comments:

1. To help make the document less cluttered, please reduce the topography contour lines to 10' intervals.

RESPONSE: Acknowledged. The preliminary plat drawing has been revised to only show 10' contour intervals.

2. Please add a note to the plat document that no gas wells are present and include the source of your information.

RESPONSE: Acknowledged. A note has been added to the revised drawing.

3. Please show the existing ROW for Main Street and label the portion to be vacated. RESPONSE: Acknowledged. The existing Main Street ROW that will be vacated is labeled on the updated Preliminary Plat drawing.

Traffic Review Comments:

1. Sidewalk needs to be shown on the plat, to the extent of the plat boundary.

RESPONSE: Acknowledged. The proposed sidewalk along Main Street has been added to the updated Preliminary Plat drawing.
