Mr. McGuire,

During our Preliminary Development Plan review we received a comment stating that "The proposed zoning district (CP-2) requires a high impact landscaping buffer when adjacent to RP-2 (located to the west) and R-1 (located to the north) zoning districts. The requirements of the buffer include a 6' fence."

It was discussed, in our Applicant Meeting, that the existing wooded area and stream buffer would prove to be problematic for the installation of a fence. It was also discussed that the fence should not be installed on the top of the existing retaining wall.

As a result, I am requesting that we be able to use the existing wooded area as the buffer so we can eliminate the requirement for the fence. I have attached two pictures, showing the existing wooded area which is located between our site and the adjacent RP-2 and R-1 zoning districts. The pictures were taken in June and November of 2021, and both show dense vegetation throughout the year.
