The Public Works Department hereby approves the final development plans dated July 22, 2011, for the above referenced project. These plans were received by our department on July 25, 2011. The following conditions must be satisfied prior to the start of construction.

- 1. Contact Public Works Inspections (816) 969-1829 at least 48 hours prior to the onset of construction.
- 2. Submit a Land Disturbance Permit application and the required attachments to the Erosion Control Specialist prior to any land disturbance activities that are to occur prior to obtaining a building permit. Approval of these plans does not constitute approval of the erosion control plan. Contact Barton Reese at (816) 969-1832 for new land disturbance permitting details.
- 3. Contact the Right-of-Way Inspector at (816) 969-1838 prior to any land disturbance activities within the rights-of-way. These activities may require a permit.
- 4. Any public improvements will require a mylar(s) to be provided to Public Works Engineering. Two CDs with the plans in TIFF format are also needed. The mylar(s) and CDs should be sent to Public Works Inspections at the address on the letterhead.
- 5. The engineer's cost estimate has been accepted for this project. An inspection and plan review fee of **\$2,074.99** has been received.
- 6. Note that any improvements installed over City utilities or within City easements will not be repaired or replaced if future utility maintenance is required, including, but not limited to, pavement, curbing and guttering, landscaping, trees, shrubs, or other items.
