- 1. The BFPD vault sump must be daylighted or connected to the storm water system, as an aggregate pit is not allowed. Show in the plans how the BFPD vault sump will be drained.
- 2. Sheet flow across the top of the BFPD within a parking lot does not satisfy the requirement to grade the vault area to drain away. To achieve an appropriate design, grass areas are usually better locations for the BFPD vault. Please reevaluate the design.
