## **Tentative Schedule**

Submit revised plans by <u>4pm on Tuesday, June 04, 2024.</u> Revised documents shall be uploaded to the application through the online portal.

City Council date will be set after all subdivision related public improvements have been completed and a Certificate of Final Acceptance has been issued. In lieu of completion of public improvements, an escrow secured with cash or an irrevocable letter of credit shall be deposited with the City to secure the completion of all public improvements prior to scheduling a City Council date.

If the revised submittal deadline is not met or plans are deficient, the item will be moved to a later meeting and a new deadline will be set. Future deadlines and meeting dates can be found on the "Planning Commission Meeting Dates" handout. Dates are subject to change; we will keep you informed throughout the process.

#### Excise Tax

On April 1, 1998, an excise tax on new development for road construction went into effect. This tax is levied based on the type of development and trips generated. 2. SIDEWALK EASEMENT NOTE. The second to last sentence in the dedication paragraph makes reference to Lot 9, but no such lot number abuts the subject plat's boundary. Revise or remove this last sentence as needed.

3. ADDRESSES. See a copy of the marked up drawing with assigned addresses via the CityView portal (it has a tag of "address markup" at the end of the file title. Please reach out with any questions you may have on the assigned addresses.

4. CC&Rs. An addendum to the existing CC&Rs shall be provided that bring the new lots into the existing HOA and its ownership and maintenance responsibilities.

1. All required engineering plans and studies, including water lines, sanitary sewers, storm drainage, streets and erosion and sediment control shall be submitted along with the final plat and approved prior to the approval of the final plat. All public infrastructure must be substantially complete, prior to the issuance of any building permits.

2. A Master Drainage Plan (MDP) shall be submitted and approved in accordance with the City's Design and Construction Manual for all areas of the development, including all surrounding impacted areas, along with the engineering plans for the development. The MDP shall address drainage level of service issues on an individual lot basis.

3. All Engineering Plan Review and Inspection Fees shall be paid prior to approval of the associated engineering plans and prior to the issuance of any site development permits or the start of construction (excluding land disturbance permit).

4. All subdivision-related public improvements must have a Certificate of Final Acceptance prior to approval of the final plat, unless security is provided in the manner set forth in the City's Unified Development Ordinance (UDO) Section 7.340. If security is provided, building permits may be issued upon issuance of a Certificate of Substantial

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Completion of the public infrastructure as outlined in Article 3, Division V, Sections 3.540 and 3.550 and Article 3, Division IV, Section 3.475 of the UDO, respectively.

5. The As-graded Master Drainage Plan shall be submitted to and accepted by the City prior to the issuance of a Certificate of Substantial Completion and prior to the issuance of any building permits for the development.

6. A Land Disturbance Permit shall be obtained from the City if groundbreaking will take place prior to the issuance of a site development permit, building permit, or prior to the approval of the Final Development Plan / Engineering Plans.

7. A restriction note shall be included on the final plat stating: "Individual lot owner(s) shall not change or obstruct the drainage flow paths on the lots, as shown on the Master Drainage Plan, unless specific application is made and approved by the City Engineer."

8. All ADA sidewalk ramps shall be constructed by the developer at the time the street is constructed.

9. All sidewalks adjacent to a common area tract, unplatted land or any land where no structure is intended to be built, and is required, shall be constructed by the developer at the time the street is constructed.
