The example provided depicts drastically different lighting levels in the area between the front door and the canopy from what is being proposed on this development's photometric plan, please reconcile with a more accurate example. The Director has stated that he is willing to look at what is being proposed once it is

installed with the understanding that if the lighting levels are not sufficient to meet the intended CPTED goal additional lighting will be required.
